## Transition Day Thursday 4th July

You will meet your tutor and spend the day with your new tutor group. As well as spending time getting to know the school and your new friends you will also have sample lessons from some of our fantastic teachers.

- Please arrive by 8.50 am and go to the main school reception.
- Wear your usual primary school uniform (trainers are ok).
- Bring a pen or pencil.
- Bring £3.60 cash for school lunch, this will cover a main course and pudding of your choice and a bottle of water. If you prefer you can bring a packed lunch. Bring a water bottle to use during the day. You can refill it if you need to.
- School will finish at 3.20 pm.
- Pupils eligible for free school meals will receive a main course and pudding of their choice.

## International Day Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July

This is a really exciting day where you will work with teachers across the school on a variety of activities with an international theme.

- Please arrive by 8.50am and go to the main school reception.
- You do not need to wear your school uniform but please make sure clothes are comfortable and suitable. No open toe shoes please.
- Lunch arrangements will be the same as the previous day, please bring either £3.60 or a packed lunch. Free school meals will be provided to eligible students.
- School will finish at 3.20 pm.

Pupils will be able to travel on the school buses morning and afternoon free of charge with the exception of Trent Barton Buses (The Keyworth Connection) where fares are applicable, for more information visit www.trentbarton.co.uk. Pupils will be escorted at the end of each day to the bus bay for the journey home.
